

## Thailand Pass for International Staff and Students entering to Thailand

\*\*\*\*\*

**Thailand Pass** is online based system to monitor and collect data of visitors or people re-entry to Thailand. It created to replace the Certificate of Entry (COE). To enter to Thailand, Thai and non-Thai citizens must apply through this system start from November 2021.

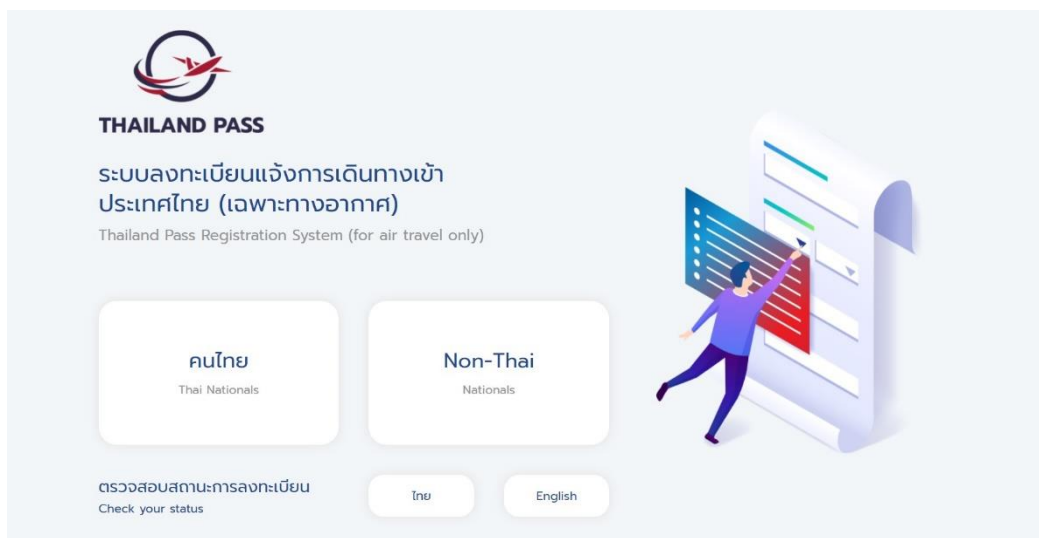
### Prepare the required documents

- Passport
- Thai Visa (if required)
- Vaccination certificate
- COVID-19 insurance within minimum coverage of USD 50,000
- Paid Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ)/ SHA+ hotel reservation confirmation (including RT-PCR test fee).

***\*Note\****: List of countries which does not required of 14-day State Quarantine in Thailand maybe changed. Please update your information with Thai consular in your country.

### Register on [tp.consular.go.th](https://tp.consular.go.th)

***\*\*Note\*\****: Recommend registering in the system 7-10 days before your planning flight

## THAILAND PASS TRAVELER JOURNEY

Revised 27 October 2021 (18.00 hrs.)

### STEP 1

**Prepare the required documents**

- Passport
- Thai Visa (if required)
- Vaccination certificate (required for entry to the Sandbox Programs and the Test and Go scheme).
- COVID-19 insurance with minimum coverage of 50,000 USD.
- Paid AQ / SHA+ hotel reservation confirmation (including RT-PCR test fee).



### STEP 2

**Register on [tp.consular.go.th](http://tp.consular.go.th)**  
(At least 7 days before your travel)

- Fill in your details (including the immigration forms) and upload the required documents (as described in Step 1).
- Wait for the pre-approval of your vaccination certificate.
- Obtain the Thailand Pass QR Code.



### STEP 3

**Get a COVID-19 RT-PCR test within 72 hours before departure with a negative result**

### STEP 4

**Travel to Thailand**

- Have your Thailand Pass QR Code and COVID-19 RT-PCR test result checked by officers.
- Pass through disease control and immigration checkpoints.
- Undergo COVID-19 RT-PCR test at the airport / hotel / designated accommodation (in case of entry to the Sandbox Programs or the Test and Go scheme).



### STEP 5

- Undergo quarantine at your AQ hotel (in case of AQ)
- Proceed to your SHA+ hotel (in case of Sandbox Programs)
- Proceed to your AQ / SHA+ hotel (in case of the Test and Go scheme)
