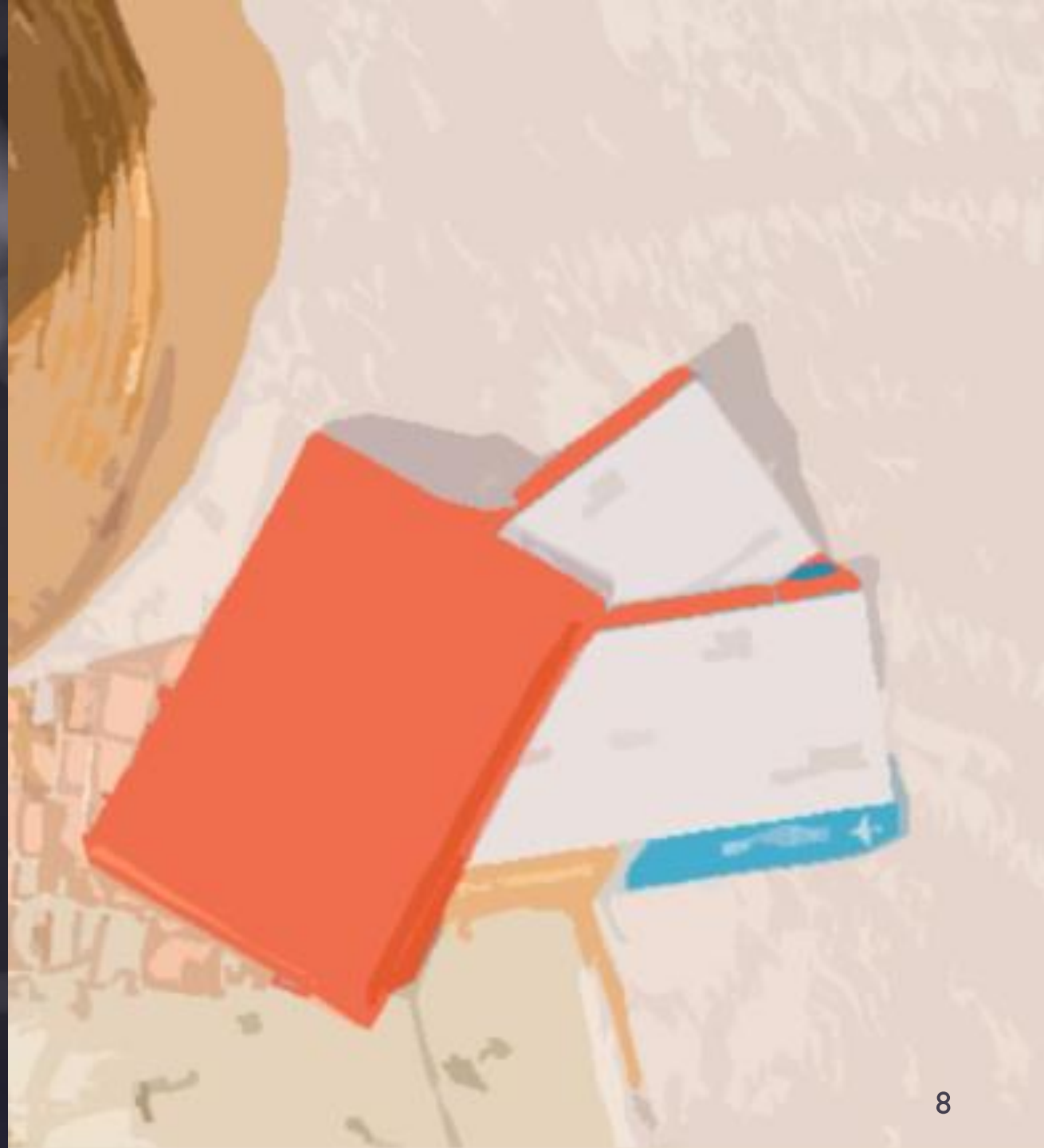

# VISA Timeline

Depending on your duration of stay

Before entry to Thailand, students should hold the **Non-Immigrant Education VISA** which they must apply through procedure with Thai Embassy in their own country.

\*

Please make sure your accommodation landlord reports your stay to the system. On campus dormitory & hotel are done automatically.

The VISA extension must be done **30 days before** the expiration date. Do not wait for it to expire.

If you wish to travel outside of Thailand and return, you must obtain a re-entry stamp before leaving otherwise VISA will be **voided**.

# Entry to Thailand

# 90 Days Report

The notification of staying over 90 days

\*This is a separate procedure from VISA.

**After getting the VISA extension,**

international staff/student will be allowed to stay further in Thailand for the duration of work/study but not more than a year.

The 90-days report to Immigration Bureau is required to inform your current address every 90 days.

(You may report in advance for 15 days before the due date.)

**!!! The notification of staying in the Thailand over 90 days is in no way equivalent to a visa extension and vice versa.**

– If a foreigner staying in the kingdom over 90 days without notifying the Immigration Bureau or notifying the Immigration Bureau later than the set period, **a fine of 2,000.- THB** will be collected.

– If a foreigner leaves the country and re-enters, the day count starts at 1 in every case.

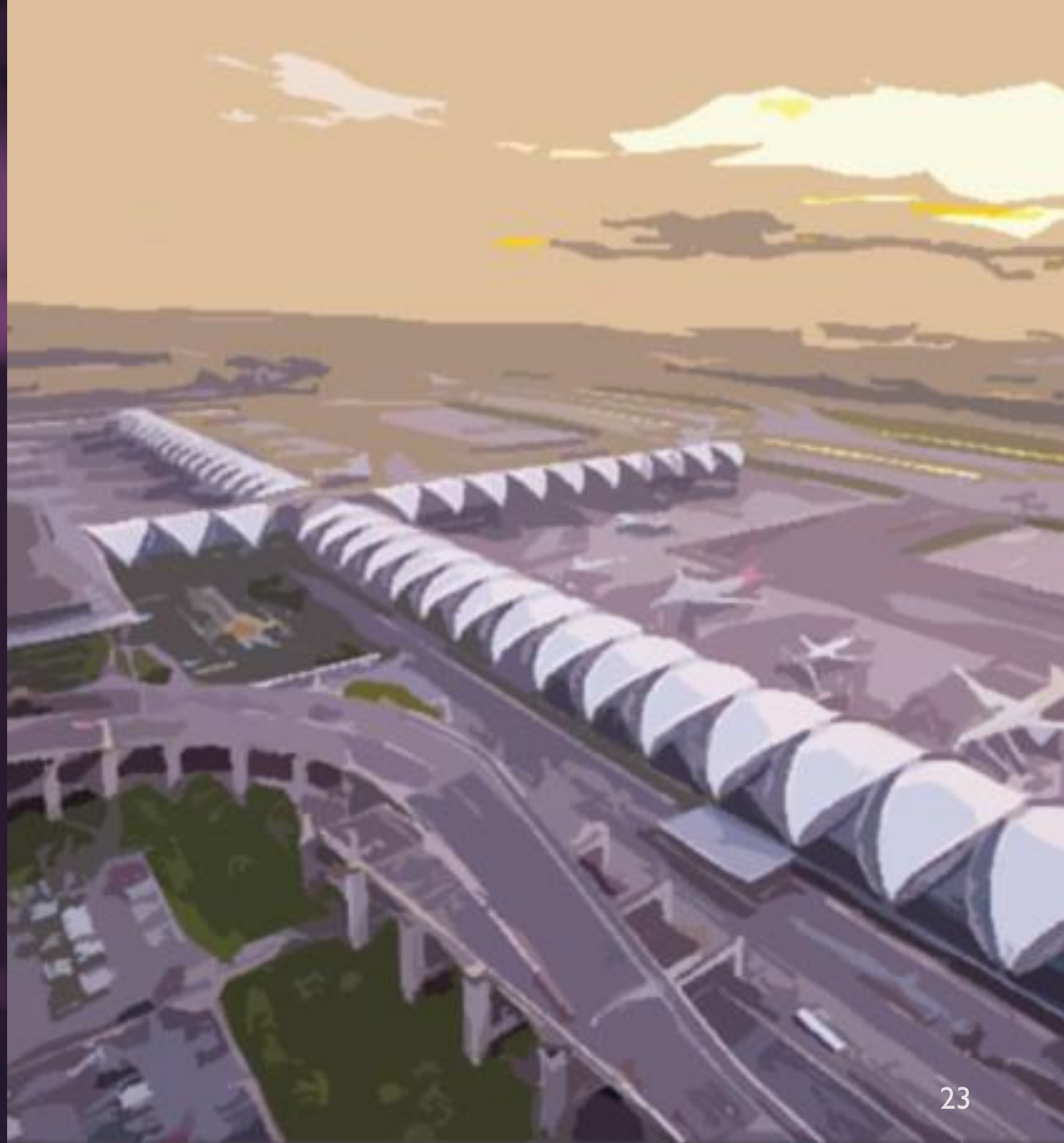


## No Re-entry permit/stamp

# Transit How to get to KMUTNB

## Option 1. Direct taxi from/to the airport

The fare ranges around 350 - 450 THB  
(for Suvarnabhumi International Airport)

The fare ranges around 200 - 300 THB  
(for Don Mueang International Airport)

Depending on the traffic condition  
(excluded Taxi airport area fee charge 50 THB and  
tollway fees must be paid by passenger).

Taxis are everywhere in Bangkok, so only use taxis  
that use their meters, found in a specific area  
dedicated to Public Taxi (suggested).



# Transit How to get to KMUTNB

## Option 2. Airport Rail Link and MRT (Metro)

The closest MRT station to KMUTNB is Wong Sawang station (MRT purple line)

- > Take the Airport Rail Link at Suvarnabhumi International Airport to Makkasan station,
- > walk along the Skywalk (500 meters) to Phetchaburi MRT - Blue Line
- > Take MRT Blue Line travel to Tao Poon station
- > transit to MRT - Purple Line travel to: Wong Sawang station,
- > take taxi to KMUTNB, the fare ranges for taxi is from about 60 - 90 THB (8 km.) depending on the traffic condition.

# KMUTNB Dormitory Regulations

## Regulations

1. The dormitory 's gate opening time: 5.00 am to 11.00 pm
2. The dormitory does not allow any unregistered individual to access the dormitory rooms.
  - Male and Female residential buildings are separated
3. The resident who is needed to gain access to the dormitory after 11.00 pm, one must contact to the dormitory office 3 days in advance otherwise, student residence right could be terminated if the student continues to break the rules several times.
4. Cooking is not permitted inside the room. If the damages occurred, student will be fined accordingly.
5. The dormitory items and furniture are not allowed to be moved between rooms.
  - In case of student without keycard whether forgot or dropped, student will be fined 50 THB per keycard/time at the dormitory office to get a new one.
6. Do Not cause a neighbor noise annoyance
7. These actions are not allowed; smoking, alcohol drinking, bringing alcoholic drinks inside the dormitory area.
8. No pets allowed
9. No clothes hanging at the balcony fence or handrail.
10. Do not throw or drop any items from the balcony.
11. Student must report the damage of the room structure, furniture, or electronics at the dormitory office.
12. In case of moving in or out before/after the working hour, student must contact the coordinator or dormitory office 3 days in advance.
13. The free wi-fi addresses are DORM\_A by TOT, DORM\_B by TOT
