KMUTNB Ranking 2025 - 2026



On 18 June 2025, the U.S. News Best Global Universities Rankings officially announced the rankings of the world's top 2,250 universities. KMUTNB has been ranked at the 1,188th in the world and the 7th among Thai universities, out of 14 Thai institutions included in the rankings. Additionally, KMUTNB was ranked among the top 10 universities of Thailand in five subject areas, including Chemistry, Engineering, Materials Science, Mathematics, Polymer Science.



On 23 April 2025, Times Higher Education (THE) announced the Asia University Rankings 2025. This year, KMUTNB was ranked the 6th among Thai universities and placed among the top 401–500 universities in Asia.



On 19 June 2025, the QS World University Rankings 2026 were released by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS). KMUTNB has been placed in the 1201–1400 range globally and the 8th among Thai universities for the second consecutive year. This marks the third consecutive year that KMUTNB has been included in the global rankings in the 1201–1400 range. KMUTNB shares the 8th spot in Thailand with KMITL and SUT, out of a total of 15 Thai universities ranked this year.



On 18 June 2025, the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Rankings 2025 was officially announced. KMUTNB was ranked among the top 801–1000 universities globally, and among 83 Thai universities, across 8 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
