160th Anniversary of Thai-German relations "EV Hackathon for Sustainability"



In 2022, the diplomatic relations between the Kingdom of Thailand and the Federal Republic of Germany have been established for 160 years. During the past 160 years, both countries see the development of bilateral cooperation in many areas.

Especially, in the area of education, the Royal Thai Government and the German Government cooperated to found the "Thai-

German Technical School" in 1959, which became known as King's Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok (KMUTNB) nowadays. KMUTNB, therefore, is a testimony of cordial ties and friendship between the two countries. To commemorate the 160th anniversary of Thai-German diplomatic relations, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, in collaboration with the German Embassy in Bangkok and KMUTNB, will organize the EV Hackathon Project between July to August 2022.

On 15 February 2022, the delegation from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, including Mr. Krai Mahasandana, Deputy Director General of the Department of European Affairs, Ms. Marinee Suwanmoli, Director of Central Europe Division and Ms. Venus Aswabhum, visited KMUTNB to have a meeting with the team of KMUTNB's executives led by Prof. Dr.-Ing. habil.
