

International Exchange Student Card (IES Card)



What is an IES card?

International Exchange Student card is a card which proof your status as Exchange Student at KMUTNB.

How to get IES card?

Method 1: Students apply by themselves

Appropriate for

- Students in Bangkok Campus
- Student who are free in business days
- Activities involved with 1 – 3 students

How to

1. Download the form
2. Fill in the form + The Faculty's authority signature
3. Contact ICC, take a photo and print a card
4. Wait to collect immediately or the next business day

Method 2: The faculty applies for students

Appropriate for

- Apply in advance use immediately when arrive
- Provide help to students
- Students in Rayong or Prachinburi Campuses
- Activities attended by many students

How to

1. The faculty request information and photo file via email
2. The faculty's authority signs or issue a memorandum
3. Sent information or a photo file to ICC
4. ICC sent cards to students within 1/3 business days

Who should have IES card

Inbound Exchange Students/Staff at least 7 days visiting

IAESTE Students who are doing internship in KMUTNB

Full time students

Yearly contract staff/Lectures

Holding an IES card give you free access to the KMUTNB Wi-Fi and access to: Library, Nursing Room, Student Affairs Department, Faculties and Computer Room
